### What should I do if I wish to land Back of Boat lobsters prior to the changes to Fish Eye being rolled out?

It is anticipated that the updated version of Fish Eye and CatchER (app) will be rolled out before the end of September 2020.

If fishers are wanting to land Back of Boat (BOB) lobsters prior to the changes being implemented, this is how Fish Eye should be completed in the interim:

#### Pre-landing Nomination

Complete as normal, except please include information in the comments field as to the number of BOB lobsters being landed. For example, if you were landing 30 BOB lobsters, you should indicate '30 BOB lobsters'.

#### Post-landing Nomination

Weigh the BOB lobsters as a separate consignment, which is weighed first.

Indicate the Registered Receiver for the BOB consignment as an existing registered receiver, who you do NOT normally use.

#### Note:

- BOB lobsters will need to be in sealed containers before entering the approved landing area.
- BOB lobster containers can have the tags removed 10 minutes after the weight has been reported in Fish Eye.
